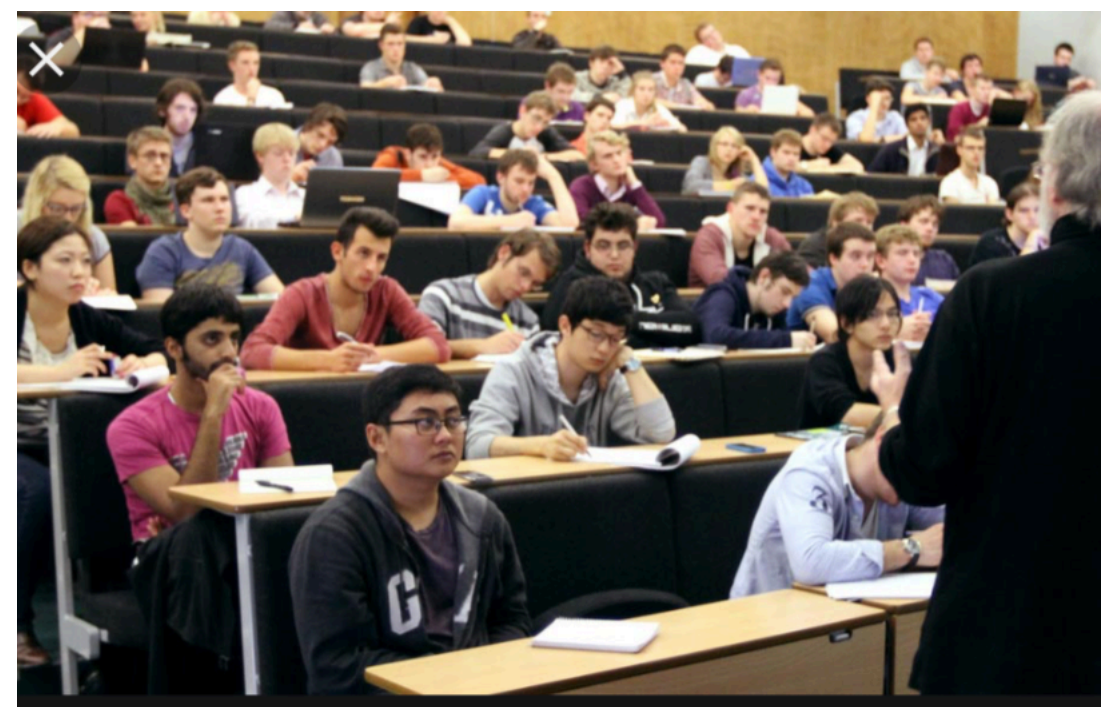
At the last count there were 730,000 confirmed credentials in the US alone.

Degrees, certificates, apprenticeships, licenses... A vast, complicated array of information, traditionally held in document form, in silos. No transparency, and no easy way for anyone to make well informed decisions about credentials, their value or their relevance.

Small wonder that a consortium of major businesses and non-profits decided to do something about it.

The objective was to create a centralized Credential Registry to house up-to-date information about all credentials, a common description language to enable comparability, and a platform to support customized applications to search and retrieve information

Credential information is exposed as linked open data, with applications built on top. The other big idea was to make it all competency based. Credentials are linked to competency frameworks. These describe the skills, knowledge and abilities required to achieve the credential - or obtained as a result of the credential.

CaSS stores all these frameworks, and is used in search and matching algorithms. It collects, connects and maintains up to date information at scale.

Users can search for skills, or careers that match skills, and sort by geography and a multitude of other criteria.

This is a huge project, used nationally and set to spread internationally.

It's an example of the ease with which CaSS can be integrated into complex systems, and its impressive scalability.
